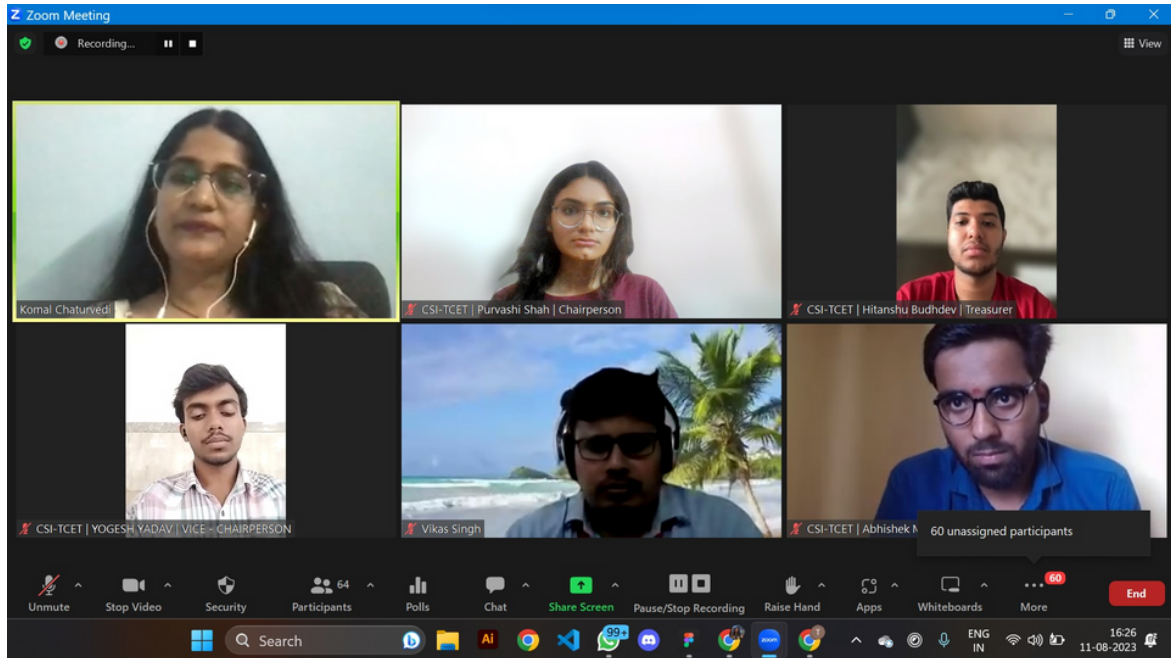

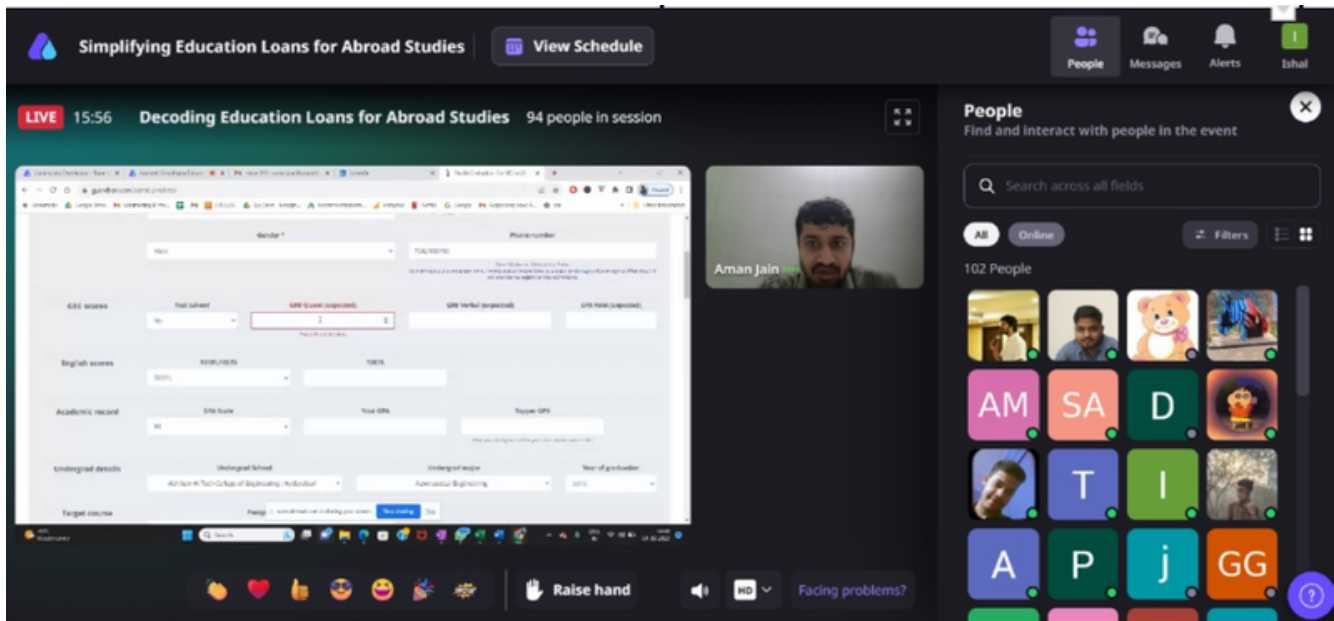

LOCAL INDUSTRIAL VISIT



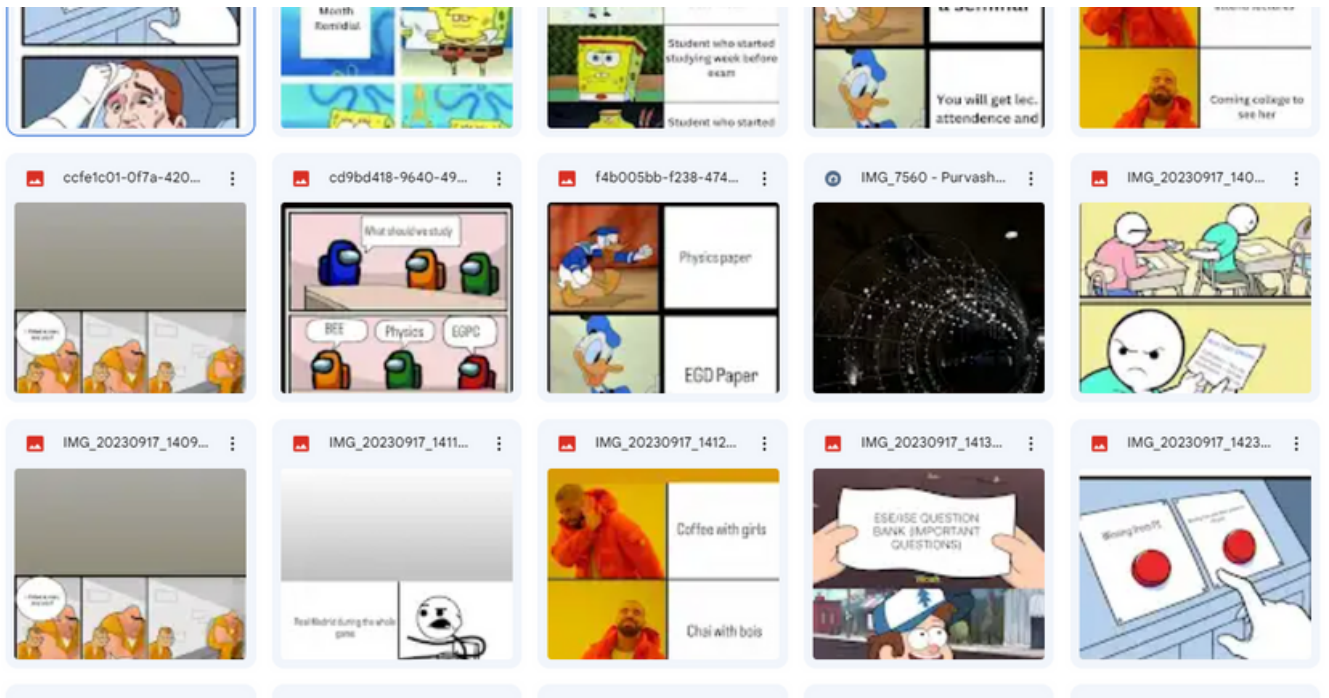
