CODE DUMP



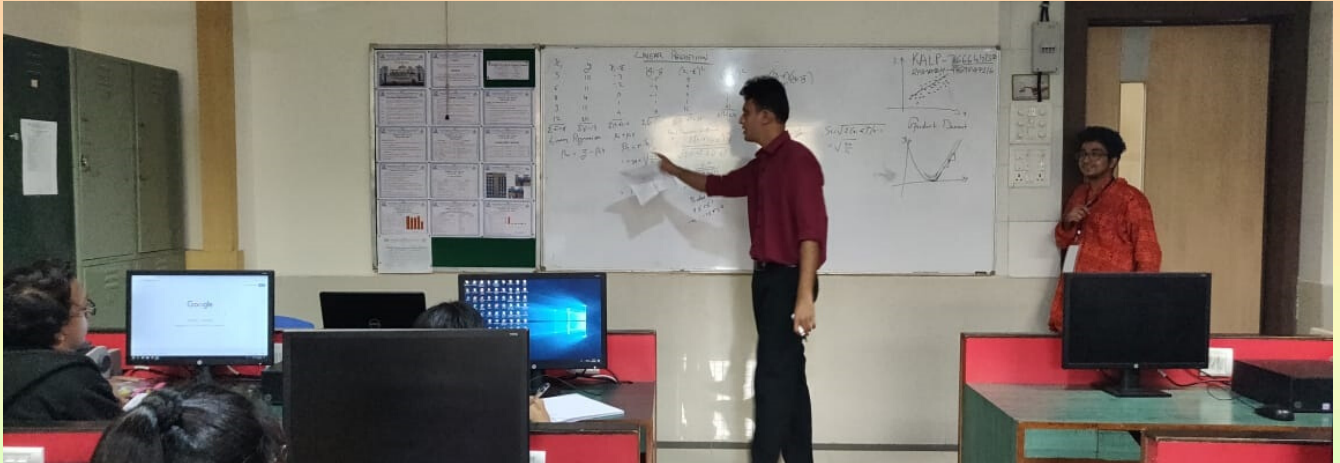
An online coding competition, named Code Dump was held during Zephyr.

Two rounds, elimination and final, were held in the event.

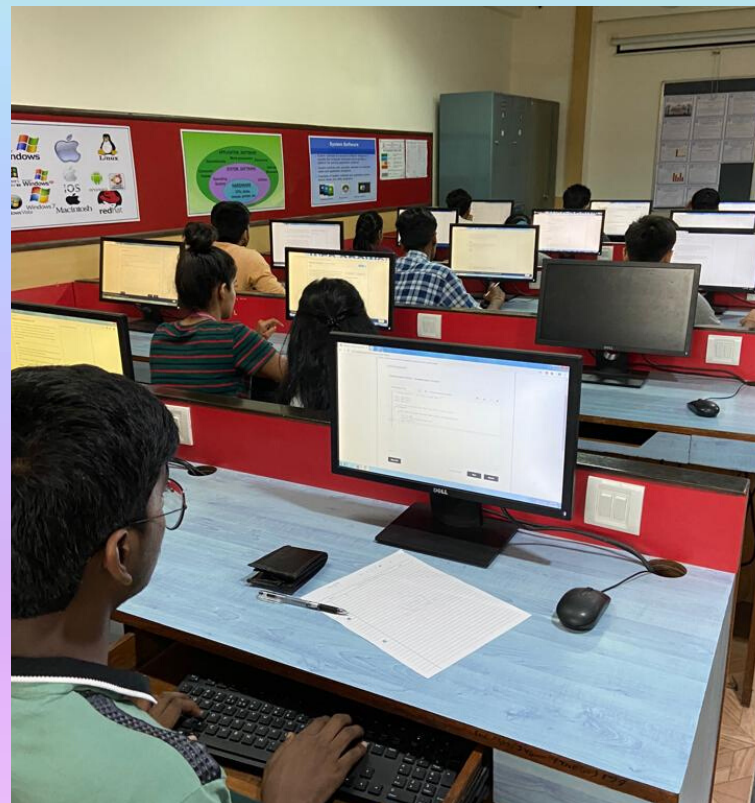
CODE BLASTERS

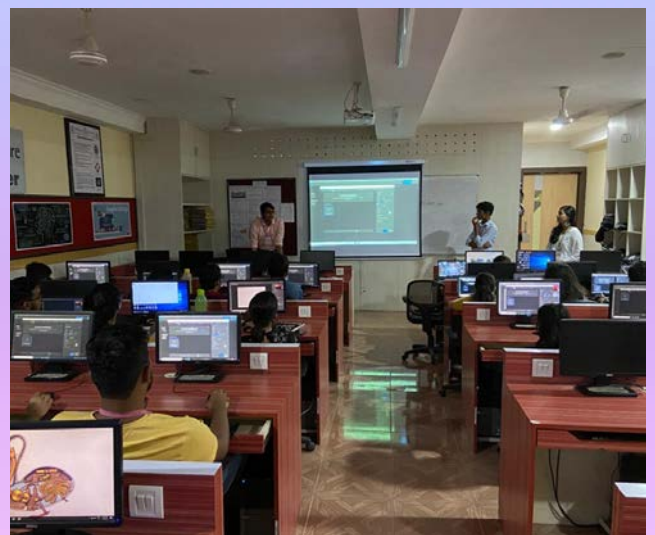


ACM TCET Student Chapter conducted a workshop on Graphic Design on 28th January, 2020.

They learnt designing and also implemented it.



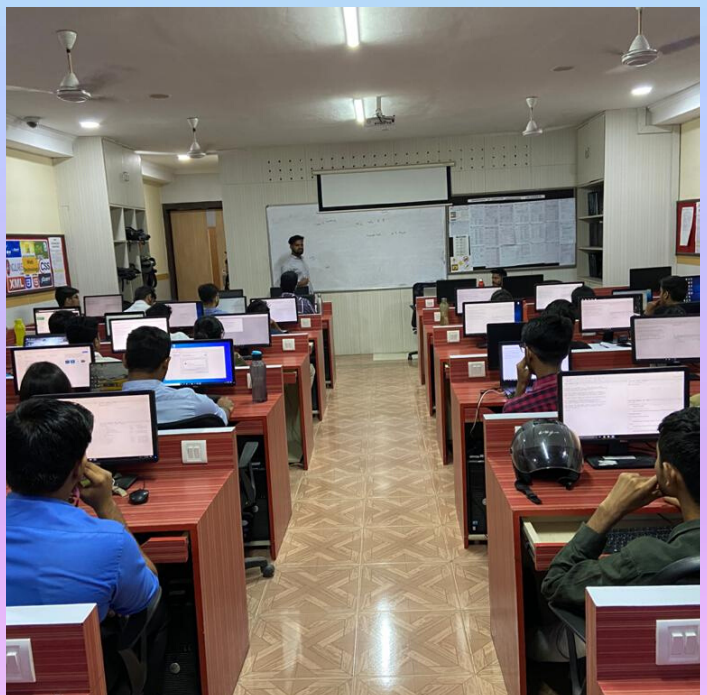
MACHINE LEARNING WORKSHOP

IT-Department senior students, Gopi Mehta and Aditya Nambiar conducted this session.

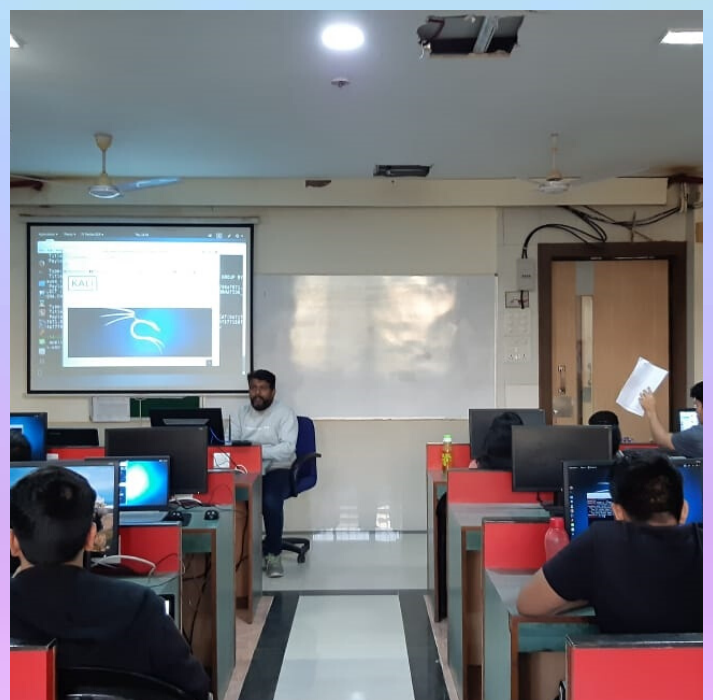
ETHICAL HACKING WORKSHOP
