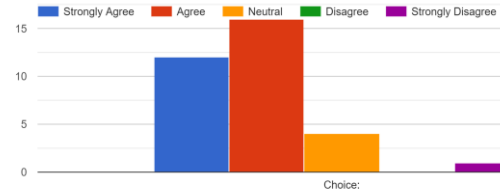

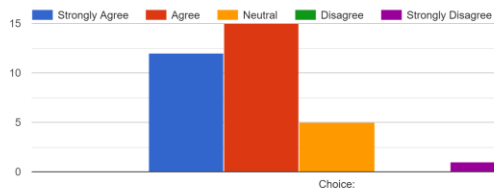

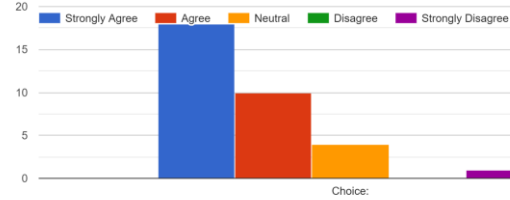
Knowledge gained



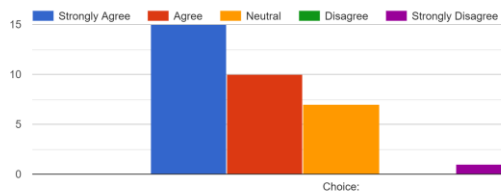

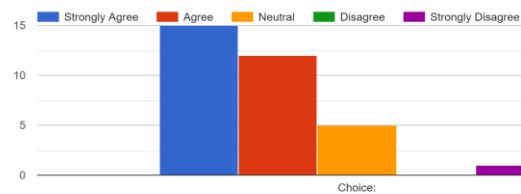
