ADO.NET WORKSHOP

- A workshop on “ADO.NET” was conducted by IT Department under TCET – ACM Student Chapter in lab 207 dated on 05 and 06 February 2019.
- It was a very beneficial workshop where students learnt how to access databases using ado.net, efficient use and various applications of ado.net.
