

AICTE Scholarship Schemes/Fellowship/ Internship schemes

Scholarship Schemes- Ministry of Tribal Affairs GOI

1. Post Matric Scholarship to ST students: All Post Matriculation Courses
 - Students studying in any recognized course from a recognized institution for which qualification is from Class XI to Ph.D. level
 - Demand driven Parental income from all sources should be less than Rs.2.50 lakhs per annum.
 - Compulsory fees charged by educational institutions reimbursed subject to the limit fixed by the State Level Fee fixation committee.
2. National Overseas Scholarships for ST Candidates for Studying Abroad: Post Graduation, PhD & Post-Doctoral studies abroad.
 - To pursue Post Graduation, PhD and Post-Doctoral study abroad.
 - 30% slots are earmarked for girls.
 - 20 awards every year. 17 awards for STs and 3 for students belonging to Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTG).
 - Parental/family income should not to exceed Rs.6.00 lakhs pa
 - Fully funded by Central Government.
 - Covers tuition fees, travel allowance, living allowance MEA release the scholarship through Indian Embassies abroad. Further, the bills raised by the MEA is reimbursed by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs

AICTE Pragati Scholarship Scheme - Financial assistance to girl students pursuing Degree in Technical Education

Eligibility:

- Students admitted in AICTE approved institution in:
1st year of Degree level course.
OR
2nd year of Degree level course through lateral entry.
- Maximum two girls per family

- Family Income up to Rs. 8 lakhs per annum.

Amount of Scholarship: Rs. 50,000/- pa for every year of study.

No. of Scholarships for Maharashtra State: 553 for Degree Courses.

AICTE Saksham Scholarship Scheme - Financial assistance to specially-abled students pursuing Degree in technical education.

Eligibility:

- Students admitted in AICTE approved institution in:
1st year of Degree level course.
OR
2nd year of Degree level course through lateral entry.
- Disability \geq 40%
- Family income upto Rs. 8 lakh per annum.

Amount of Scholarship: Rs. 50,000/- pa for every year of study.

No. of Scholarships: All eligible specially-abled students.

AICTE Swanath Scholarship Scheme - Started in the year 2021-22 to provide financial assistance to the orphans/wards of parents died due to Covid-19/ wards of Armed Forces and Central Paramilitary Forces martyred in action (Shaheed) pursuing Degree in AICTE approved institutions & courses.

Eligibility:

- Students admitted in AICTE approved institution in 1st/2nd/3r/4th year of Degree level course.
- Family Income upto Rs. 8 lakh per annum.

Amount of Scholarship:Rs.50,000/- pa for every year of study.

No. of Scholarships: 1000 for Degree Courses

AICTE MITACS GLOBALINK RESEARCH INTERNSHIP (GRI) - Financial support to students for undergoing internship in Canadian Universities.

Eligibility:

- Enrolled in full-time UG program (3rd year in AICTE approved institutions and AICTE approved courses.
- Minimum GPA of 85%
- At least 18 years of age
- Demonstrate oral and witte fluency in English.

Subjects for the Global Research Internships: Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) disciplines.

Duration: 12 weeks (between May and September 2022).

No of internships: 300

Financial Support per student:

- GRI program is CAD \$12000.

- Borne by the AICTE and Mitacs jointly.

AICTE YOUTH UNDERTAKING VISIT FOR ACQUIRING KNOWLEDGE (YUVAK) SCHEME -

The scheme is intended for providing Financial Grant for conducting a Study Tour of ATAL TUNNEL by Students / faculty of AICTE approved Institutions in the field of technical education.

Eligibility:

1. AICTE approved Institutions in the field of Technical Education having NIRF ranking between 1 to 500 are eligible for the grant
2. Students should be from Regular 2nd & 3rd year B.E./B.Tech. and/ or Integrated M. Tech. students of Civil, Mechanical & Structural Engineering disciplines
3. Selected students of the team should have minimum CGPA of 8.5 in the previous semester
4. Only ONE proposal per Institute will be accepted in a financial year

Duration of Study Tour and Limit of Financial Grants: The Study Tour will be for a period of 3 days excluding journey period from the Institution to Manali & back

Financial Grant: 25 Institutions from NRO & NWRO Regions and 75 Institutions from remaining regions in a financial year. Grant will be for Team of 10 Students + 1 Faculty member of the institute as per details below:

- Institute of NRO & NWRO Region: Rs. 1,70,000/-
- Institute of Other Region: Rs. 2,00,000/-

AICTE-INAЕ TRAVEL GRANT (TG) - Financial assistance to students for presenting their research paper in conferences abroad.

Eligibility:

- Pre-final and final year students of B.E./B.Tech or Integrated M.Tech and first & second year students of M.E./M.Tech from AICTE approved institutions. \
- Min. 7.0 CGPA or 65% and above.
- Letter of acceptance and presenting a research paper.
- Once during the course of study.

Financial support: Upto Rs. 1 lakh per student. For attending online conferences in 2021-22 AICTE is providing financial support of Rs. 25,000/-

AICTE SUPPORT TO STUDENTS FOR PARTICIPATING IN COMPETITION ABROAD (ASSPCA) - Financial assistance to students for participating in competitions abroad.

Eligibility:

- Team of minimum 2 to 10 students
- Students pursuing degree in Engineering/ Technology from AICTE approved institutions.
- Letter of acceptance/ invitation for international competition abroad.
- Team must have won the top honors in a national level event.
- Once during the course of study

Financial Support: Upto Rs. 10 lakh per team (Rs. 1 lakh per student)
