All eligible students have to apply Online on <http://mahadbtmahait.gov.in> for the fresh / Renewal of scholarship-2019-20. Fill the online form as per given schedule or your form will be send back in your login.

- **Scheme - 1)Rajarshi Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulk Shishyavrutti Yojna – 2019-20.**

All the F.E. to B.E. students admitted through CAP Round of the college are hereby informed that, economically backward class students are given 50% amount of tuition fees and 50 % of Exam Fee from Jt. Directorate, Technical Education, Regional Office, Mumbai for academic year 2019-20 as a EBC scholarship.

Jt. Director, Technical Education, Regional Office, Mumbai letter no./Vkamu/Tanishi/EBC/2018/1988, Dated : 22-06-2018 has directed to implement the scheme. Hence all eligible aspiring Candidates do not have to pay their 50% tuition fees at the time of admission for the academic year 2019-20.

Eligibility Criteria:-

Eligibility Criteria: (As per the GR Dated 07th Oct 2017,01st March 2018, 31st March 2018)

- Applicant should have Nationality of India.
- Candidate should be Domicile of Maharashtra State.
- Applicant should be "Bonafide Student of Institute" and admitted for Professional and Technical course (Diploma / Graduation / Post Graduation Degree) as mentioned in GR
- Deemed University and Private university is not applicable
- Candidate should be admitted through Centralized Admission Process (CAP).
- Applicant should not avail any other scholarship/stipend.
- For current Academic Year, Only 2 child from family are allowed for benefit of scheme.
- The Total Annual Income of Family / Guardian should not be more than Rs. 8,00,000/- / Eight Lakhs.
- Minimum 75 % attendance in previous semester (Exception for fresh admitted in College).
- During course duration, candidate should not have a gap of 2 or more than 2 years.

The Documents Required:-

- Mark sheet of 10th (S.S.C) & Onwards.
- Domicile Certificate of Maharashtra State. (Birth certificate and Leaving certificate will not consider).
- The annual income of parents for the previous financial year 2018-19 duly certified by concerned Tahashildar upto Rs.8,00,000/- / Eight Lakhs.
- If income is less than 50% of tuition fee than student must produce the undertaking of that person who provided financial assistant or if taken education loan from bank than bank certificate. (For hard copy submission).
- State Common Entrance Test Cell, Application form.
- C.A.P. Admission allotment letter and College confirmation letter (For hard copy submission).
- Ration Card and Undertaking "In current year, not more than 2 beneficiaries from family".
- If any gap, then attached copy of gap affidavit.
- Father Death Certificate (If attached Mother Income Certificate).
- Photo copy of Pass Book and cancelled cheque (Pass book must be in the name of student and Jt. Account not applicable).

• **Scheme - 2) Dr. Punjabrao Deshmukh Vasatigrub Nirvah Bhatta Yojna (Hostel Maintenance Allowance Scheme).**

All the F.E. to B.E. students admitted through CAP Round of the college and staying in Hostel are hereby informed that, this is a plan for students of government, government funded and non-affiliated colleges / polytechnics entering the vocational courses set by the government, whose students are certified by the competent authority, as a marginal farmers or whose parents are registered laborers. They are given Hostel maintenance allowance from Directorate, Technical Education, Regional Office, Mumbai for academic year 2019-20.

Benefits:-

- a) For child of Registered Labor / Alpabudharak (Marginal Land Holder).
- For institute in MMRDA / PMRDA / Aurangabad City / Nagpur City- Rs.30,000/- for 10 months.
- For institute in other area Rs.20,000/- for 10 months.
- b) For Annual Family income up to / Rs.8,00,000/- / 8 Lakhs.
- For institute in MMRDA / PMRDA/ Aurangabad City / Nagpur City- Rs.10,000/- for 10 months.
- For Institute in other area Rs.8,000/- for 10 months.

Eligibility Criteria:

(As per the GR Dated 07th Oct 2017, 22nd Feb 2018 , 01st March 2018, 18th June 2018)

- a) Applicant should have Nationality of India.
- b) Candidate should be Domicile of Maharashtra State.
- c) Applicant should be "Bonafide Student of Institute" and admitted for Professional and Technical course (Diploma / Graduation / Post Graduation Degree) as mentioned in GR
- d) Deemed University and Private university is not applicable
- e) Candidate should be admitted through Centralized Admission Process (CAP).
- f) Applicant should not avail any other scholarship/stipend.
- g) For current Academic Year, Only 2 child from family are allowed for benefit of scheme.
- h) The Total Annual Income of Family / Guardian should not be more than 8 Lakhs.
- i) Minimum 75 % attendance in previous semester (Exception for fresh admitted in College).
- j) During course duration, candidate should not have a gap of 2 or more than 2 years.

The Documents Required:-

- a) Mark sheet of 10th (S.S.C) & Onwards.
- b) Domicile Certificate of Maharashtra State.
- c) Register Labor Certificate / Alpabudharak (Marginal Land Holder) Certificate (In case of not a child of Alpabudharak or Registered Labour then family Annual Income Certificate).
- d) Undertaking "In current year, not more than 2 beneficiary from family".
- e) CAP Related document.
- f) Hosteller documents (In case of private hostel or Paying Guest, Agreement with owner will be required.

• **Scheme - 3) Scholarship Scheme for State Minority Communities Pursuing Higher Professional Education/ All Post H.S.C. Courses. (Part-I){Technical Course(DTE)}. 2019-20.**

All the concerned students for UG & PG (B.E. and M.E.) are hereby informed that, Minorities Development Department, Government of Maharashtra is offering the Scholarship for Technical Course (Part-I of GR) –Scholarship Amount Maximum Rs.25,000/- Per Annum or Actual Fees whichever is less for pursuing Professional and Technical Education for the economically weaker and meritorious students belonging to Muslim, Sikh, Buddhist, Christian, Parsi, Jain and Jews minority communities.

Benefits:-

- For Technical Course (Part-I of GR) – Scholarship Amount Maximum Rs. 25,000/- Per Annum or Actual Tutition Fees whichever is less.

Eligibility Criteria:-

- a) Applicant should have Nationality of India.
- b) Candidate should be Domicile of Maharashtra State.
- c) Candidates should have pass SSC from Maharashtra State.
- d) Applicant should be "Bonafide Student of Institute" and admitted for Professional and Technical course (Diploma / Graduation / Post Graduation Degree) as mentioned in GR
- e) Candidate should be admitted through Centralized Admission Process (CAP) / Institute Level.
- f) Applicant should not avail any other scholarship/stipend.
- g) The Total Annual Income of Family / Guardian should not be more than Rs. 8,00,000/- 8 Lakhs.

The Documents Required:-

- a) Educational Certificate – S.S.C.(10th) & onwards.
- b) Income and Minority declaration – Affidavit on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper or Income certificate from the employer, if any. School leaving certificate can also be considered as Proof of Minority) or Self Declaration.
- c) Proof of permanent residence: - Copy of Domicile Certificate/Election Card etc.

- The Government of Maharashtra has introduced the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Service through which the beneficiaries can apply for benefit from Schemes of various departments such as 'Social Justice and Special Assistance', 'Tribal Development', 'Directorate of Higher Education', 'Directorate of Technical Education', 'School Education and Sports', 'VJNT,OBC and SBC Welfare', 'Directorate of Medical Education and Research', etc. This benefit is received directly into the Aadhaar linked bank account of the eligible beneficiaries.

- **Step 1 Online Application** - The Citizen applies for a benefit via Direct Benefit Transfer(DBT) Portal.
- **Step 2Scrutiny**- The applications process for scrutiny.
- **Step 3Allotment** - After Scrutiny sent for allotment.
- **Step 4Disbursement** - At this stage benefit is received in aadhaar link bank account of respective beneficiary.
