When the department had asked for consent for IV, no consent was received by them and now they are part of unofficial IV. As per AICTE guidance for conducting IV, compliances have to be met which is not done in these cases. Therefore, institute does not permit students to organize any unofficial IV. Institute does not accept this as IV. Still if any student proceeds on such unofficial trip, in case any eventuality happens institute will not be held responsible as institute does not recognize the same. Moreover, it will be taken on institute record which may reflect in their credential.

As per institute norms students are not supposed to be a part of unofficial industrial visit (trip) and are hereby instructed to join college on 7th January 2019. If the total attendance falls below 75% then they will be defaulter and not eligible to give semester exam.
